

Beaufort Swim School Swimming Lesson Terms and Conditions

Please read, sign and return this copy before starting the course.

1. All courses must be paid for in full, in advance of the first lesson.
2. Once a course of lessons has been paid for, no refunds can be made unless absence is caused by a serious illness which must be confirmed by a doctor's note.
3. Courses of lessons are not transferable from one swimmer to another.
4. Beaufort Sports Centre reserves the right to cancel a lesson or course at any time. In the event that a lesson is cancelled the swimmer will be credited with the amount for that lesson which will automatically be deducted from the cost of the next course of lessons.
5. Beaufort Sports Centre will use reasonable endeavours to provide the same instructor for each lesson. However, relief instructors may be used without prior notification. Instructors may change between each course of lessons.
6. Each swimmer must register with the instructor at the start of each lesson. Registration and administration time is included in each lesson.
7. If a swimmer has a medical condition, disability or any additional needs, this must be stated on the enrolment/registration form. Any changes to a swimmer's circumstances must be communicated to the sport centre or swimming instructor at the earliest opportunity to ensure that up-to-date records are maintained.
8. **The use of mobile phones or electronic devices is strictly prohibited at all times within poolside and changing room area, if found to using these items the individual will be escorted off from poolside. Repeated misuse may result in the exclusion of child with no refund offered.**
9. Children over 8 years of age must change in their individual changing room, and, if accompanied, by an adult of the same sex.
10. Beaufort Sports Centre will not under any circumstances, accept responsibility or liability in respect of any damage to or loss of any goods, articles or property of any kind brought into or left at the leisure centre.
11. Places will initially be allocated to those swimmers already on the lesson programme. To secure a place for the next course on the allocated class, the customer must remain in credit at all times.
12. Class numbers are restricted to ensure a quality teaching environment and are based on the ASA Code of Practice.
13. Beaufort Sports Centre reserves the right to cancel a course and refuse to re-book a swimmer onto a course if the swimmer or their parent displays unacceptable or inappropriate behaviour, including failure to comply with these terms and conditions.
14. Swimmers who have achieved all of the outcomes within their current swimming stage will be moved onto the next level/stage at the end of each term, subject to availability.
15. When badges have been awarded by the swimming instructor they will be available along with certificates to purchase from reception.
